Serology:

- Equine viral arteritis (EVA) VN
- Vesticular stomatitis VN
(1:8 or 1:12 dilution)
- EIA via ELISA, AGID-VS form 10-11
* Global Vet Link available
- Equine piroplasmosis (*B. equi* and *B. caballi*)

Breeding Stock (semen/swabs):

- EVA VI on raw semen
- EVA qPCR on semen or EDTA blood
- Contagious equine metritis swabs

Consult import requirements for the state and/or country to which you are transporting horses, semen or embryos.
