• **Equine viral arteritis (EVA) VN**

SAMPLE: 1cc serum

PRICE: \$15.00

TURNAROUND: Run in College Station lab Monday and Friday and run in Amarillo Tuesday and Friday, results in 3-7 days.

• **Vesticular stomatitis panel VN (1:8 or 1:12 dilution)**

SAMPLE: 1 cc serum

PRICE: \$50.00

TURNAROUND: Run in College Station Monday and Wednesday and in Amarillo, Tuesday and Friday, with results in 2-5 days.

• **EIA via ELISA, AGID**

* Global Vet Link available

SAMPLE: 1 cc serum; submit a VS form 10-11

PRICE: \$6.00

TURNAROUND: Run in College Station and Amarillo on Monday and Wednesday, results same day if received by 11 a.m.

• **Equine piroplasmiasis (*T. equi* and *B. caballi*)**

SAMPLE: 1 cc serum; if Texas client, submit a TAHC form 10-07.

PRICE: \$34.00

TURNAROUND: Run in College Station and Amarillo on Monday, Wednesday and Friday; If received in the lab by 11 a.m., results in minimum of two business days.

Breeding Stock (semen/swabs):

• **EVA VI on raw semen**

SAMPLE: 10 cc of unextended raw semen from the sperm-rich fraction; ship overnight with ice pack.

PRICE: \$60.00

TURNAROUND: Run in College Station Monday through Friday, and in Amarillo, run Tuesday and Friday, with results in 3 weeks.

• **EVA qPCR on semen or EDTA blood**

SAMPLE: 2 cc semen or EDTA blood

PRICE: \$30.00

TURNAROUND: Run in College Station Monday, results in 5 business days.

• **Contagious equine metritis (CEM) swabs**

SAMPLE: Send in Amies with charcoal transport; must be in the lab on ice packs within 48 hours of collections. Submit the TVMDL CEM form. Do not submit in EDTA and avoid sending dry swabs with no transport media.

PRICE: \$15.00

TURNAROUND: Run in College Station and Amarillo Monday through Friday with results in 7 days.

Equine Pre-Purchase Drug Screen:

SAMPLE: minimum 10 cc serum

PRICE: \$120.00

TURNAROUND: Run as batched groups in College Station with results in 1-3 business days.

Please contact the lab for full test specimen requirements and a complete lists of tests available. Consult export and/or import requirements for the state and/or country to which you are transporting horses, semen or embryos.
